Context (1/2)

- societal innovation.
- education, research and societal/economic valorization.
- (apparent contradiction or asset for new innovation scales?).

While funding of innovation projects and intellectual property legislation are often regionally organized AND entrepreneurial motivation might be culturally determined, the scope of university valorization projects (production, expertise, know how and technology, sales...) is global.

- Universities are becoming *irreversibly embedded within international networks* on

- These evolutions create a tension between the goals of *regional* innovation agencies and policy makers and the *international scope* of many of the valorization initiatives











Context (2/2)

- Especially in the field of innovation & valorization of research results, University-University knowledge transfer has hardly been explored in theory and practice.






Figure 2. Emergence of patenting between EU-CN, CH-US, EU-US universities based on WO applications (Source: Global Patent Index from the European Patent Office, own set-up)


